# Pastor Ted's Message

#### THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD

The Sovereign LORD is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer,

I want to begin by thanking the El Estero Church family and friends for your thoughts and prayers for my daughter Sherry as she spent 40 days in the hospital from December 19<sup>th</sup> to January 27<sup>th</sup>. She is currently staying at my sister Jane's home in San Jose where she is undergoing outpatient

physical therapy at the Santa Clara Valley Medical Center. Although at a recent visit to the University of California at San Francisco the doctor told us that the medical team is still confused about her diagnosis, we give thanks that Sherry is making great progress. Even though she is still unable to walk, she is determined to get well and day by day she is getting stronger and stronger. Hopefully Sherry will be able to come back to Monterey by Easter.

Looking back over the past 2 months, Sherry and I truly do see the Sovereignty of God through this challenge. Funny, but Sherry's illness has really turned out to be a blessing in disguise. We have seen the hand of God at work in so many ways that we would not have experienced if not for this illness.

I was so grateful that Sherry was home from school in Massachusetts when she became ill. It would have been extremely difficult to have her sick and to be back on the east coast. Not only was she close to home, but she had the opportunity to be hospitalized at UCSF which is the number 4 hospital in the nation for neurological diseases. As I thanked the head of the neurological department at UCSF, he thanked me and said that their goal is to become number 1. Not only was she able to be hospitalized at UCSF, SCVMC is considered to be one of the best rehab facilities on the west coast. During the past two months, Sherry has been able to receive some wonderful medical care. We have been so grateful for all of her doctors, nurses, physical therapist, occupational therapist, recreational therapist, etc.

Another blessing was that we have received great support from family. One of the reasons that I wanted to return to Monterey was to be closer to family. During Sherry's illness, family has been a great source of support and encouragement. Being in Northern California where most of the family live, everyone has taken time out of their busy schedules to visit and support Sherry for which we are truly thankful.

Sherry and I both believe God has orchestrated all of these events in her life. It is not a coincidence or an anomaly but truly an act of God's Sovereign goodness and grace to us. Sherry is quite confident that God will use this for His Glory and His purposes in the years to come.

#### **Session Meeting Highlights**

Devotion. Rev. Ted Esaki. Sees the sovereignty of God reflected in what has transpired with his daughter. He believes it was God's Plan to have him move here and become the Pastor. It was difficult for Sherry when he made the decision to come to El Estero as her friends were down in Southern California. He sees God's sovereignty when looking at the impact the move here has made on Sherry's medical treatment. It has been a blessing for them to here in Monterey when Sherry was stricken. Dr. Wayne Shen visited her at CHOMP and suggested she transfer to UCSF where he knew a neurologist. Sherry's physicians at CHOMP later came to the same recommendation. UCSF is one of finest hospitals in the country for those with neurological injuries and ranked in the Top 4. After being at UCSF, Sherry was transferred to Santa Clara Valley Medical Center. It has the best Rehabilitation Department in the West. This high quality of care would not have happened if they were living LA or if the onset of disability had occurred 2 days earlier when Sherry was still back East. It is evidence of the sovereignty of God: that they were both here, Wayne knew a neurologist at UCSF, his sister, Jane's, friend was a key nursing staff member at UCSF and that the Hongo's knew the former supervisor of the SCVMC Therapy Department. Both the USCF and SCVMC contacts took a personal interest in Sherry's Treatment and Therapy Plan. Believes it all is more than a coincidence, further proof of God's sovereignty. He has seen it over and over in his life, in this, the 40<sup>th</sup> year since he committed his life to Christ. God makes known He is still in control by causing everything to work together.

**Clerk's Report**. Lynn Gunter. The Annual Statistical Report and Clerk's Annual Questionnaire for 2015 were submitted to the PC(USA). The Polity and Governance Committee of the Presbytery of San Jose will review Session Records in March. The Elder Communion Server schedule for 2016 has been released. Past Elders are also able to serve and may contact Lynn to sign up. Membership: George Tanaka passed away on December 31st. He and Jean, his wife, joined the church in 1965. George went on to serve terms as a Trustee and then as an Elder from 1968-1970. He was giving of his time and energy serving as the volunteer gardener for church over more than 20 years. It was his wish to have a private family gathering which has occurred. He is greatly missed.

**Pastor's Report**. Rev. Ted Esaki. Expressed appreciation for time off to be with his daughter during her hospitalization. Sunday School is covering: Christ, Lessons of Holy Spirit, and Gifts and Fruit of the Holy Spirit. Worship Service for month will be on Spiritual Gifts and everyone learning where they belong and staying focused on their mission. Will be conducting a New Members class on February 20<sup>th</sup>. New members to be received February 28<sup>th</sup>. He officiated at the private funeral service held for Susie Mitchell on February 6<sup>th</sup> at request of John, her husband, and June, her daughter. A friend has offered to provide 50 tickets for our members to view the new Christian movie, "Miracles from Heaven" on Palm Sunday, March 20<sup>th</sup>. More information will follow. There will be a Good Friday Service on March 25<sup>th</sup>. Wintersburg Presbyterian will be providing a Grant of \$5,000 in 2016 to assist Pastor with Outreach expenses locally. He will be leading a Tour to Holy Land in the Fall.

Light dinner will be provided. Dr. Pat Zukeran will also give the Sunday sermon message after the JEMS conference.
