Pastor Ted's Message

Great Is Thy Faithfulness

"For the steadfast love of the LORD never cease, his mercies never come to an end.

On Tuesday August 14th as our Session met for our monthly elder meeting, my devotion was on The Fruit of the Spirit is Faithfulness.
