#### MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE

In Psalm 100, the psalmist writes, "Make a joyful noise unto the Lord all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs." For the months of June and July, our ukulele group has the opportunity to visit members of our church who are no longer able to attend our Sunday worship services. This past Wednesday, June 13, we visited with Lily Uyeda. In the coming

weeks we will visit Sunrise House, Canterbury Woods, and the homes of Royal and Hiro Manaka and Johnnie and Emiko Montoya. On Sunday, June 17, for Father's Day our ukulele group provided the entertainment by singing hymns, oldie tunes, patriotic and Hawaiian songs.

Three years ago a group from my former church, Wintersburg Presbyterian Church, in Santa Ana, came to visit and played their ukuleles in our worship service. Shortly after that we began our own ukulele group. On Monday and Wednesday of each week, about 8 to 12 people gather to practice songs and to enjoy a time of rich fellowship. They enjoy not only playing their ukuleles, but they have stepped up to the opportunity to minister to our church family.

We also have Tomi Tanaka playing drums, Marian Kageyama playing the mandolin and drums, Joyce Gota playing the banjo ukulele, Dr. Cary Gota playing the clarinet, and Maiko Kojima paying the tambourine. We do have a great time gathering together each week. We appreciate the leadership of Marilyn Kodani who organizes our practices and visitations.

There are many ways that we can worship God. We can worship God by attending our Sunday services. We can worship God as we read, study, and apply His Word to our daily lives. We can also worship God as we sing songs of worship and praise to Him. We don't need to play the ukulele or any other instrument to worship God. We can worship God in our own homes and even as we drive or as we walk along the beach.
