# **Thanksgiving Message**

Thanksgiving means many things to many people. Many people think about spending time with family, as this is one of the busiest travel weekends of the year. Other people look forward to watching the football on TV, as many teams play on Thanksgiving every year. Thanksgiving is thought of as commemorating the Pilgrims and their sharing the earth's bounty with the Native Americans. And we too celebrate the blessings that God has provided for us each day. It is only right that we should consider how we Biblically observe Thanksgiving.

Thanksgiving is the perfect time of year to remind us about learning to give God thanks especially in the toughest of circumstances. There are many scripture references that are related to giving thanks.
